PARTNERSHIP CATEGORIES

SPP offers three levels of partnership, which are different in degrees of contractual cooperation, the minimum contribution to cover joint activities and the assumed number of successfully finalized final theses in cooperation with the company. The minimum financial contribution will increase from 2025.

Strategic partner is the highest level of partnership with an intense form of cooperation, which presupposes a sustained and long-term interest in common activities. A specific research team from FI is involved in the cooperation. The partner is invited to joint discussions on important matters of study and research, and is also involved in supporting PhD research by sponsoring a particular PhD student.

Partner is meant for larger companies to establish initial contact with FI MU. Each partner is assigned a contact person from FI MU faculty who participates in the development of projects with the involvement of several students.

SME partner (Small & Medium Enterprise) is an ideal option for small companies or as the first contact in the context of cooperation. The aim is to get to know each other, to understand each other better, and to identify concrete opportunities for cooperation.


